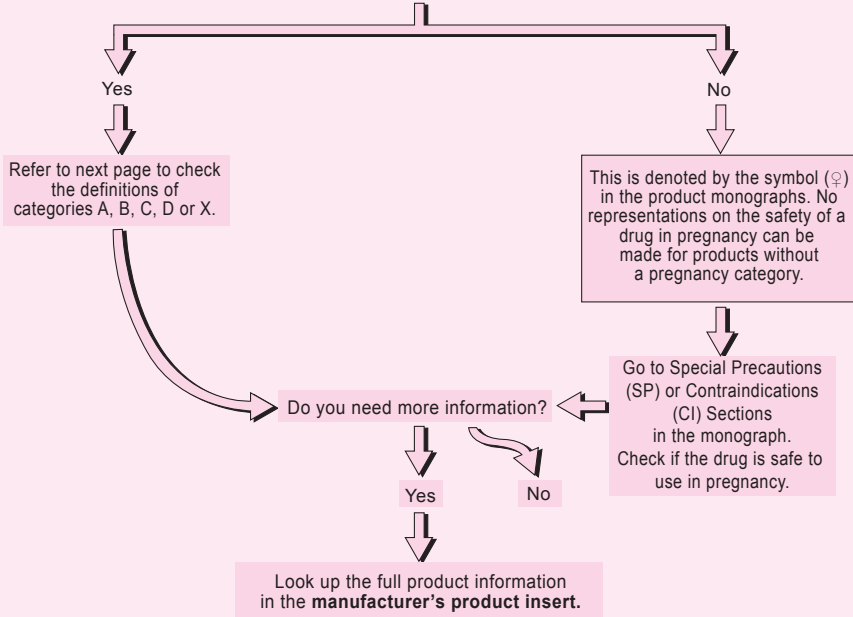

Index of Drug Safety in Pregnancy

A guide to prescribing drugs in pregnancy based on the United States Food and Drug Administration (US FDA) pregnancy categories.

Definitions of Risk Factors

These definitions are those used by the US FDA.

These categories do not imply an increasing progression of risk from A to X. Drugs are categorized based on the risk of reproductive and developmental adverse effects and on risk versus benefit considerations. Drugs in categories D, X, and in some cases C, may pose similar risk, but may be categorized differently on the basis of different risk versus benefit considerations.

Category A: Controlled studies in women fail to demonstrate a risk to the fetus in the 1st trimester (and there is no evidence of a risk in later trimesters), and the possibility of fetal harm remains remote.

Category B: Either animal-reproduction studies have not demonstrated a fetal risk, but there are no controlled studies in pregnant women or animal-reproduction studies have shown an adverse effect (other than a decrease in fertility) that was not confirmed in controlled studies in women in the 1st trimester (and there is no evidence of a risk in later trimesters).

Category C: Either studies in animals have revealed adverse effects on the fetus (teratogenic or embryocidal or other) and there are no controlled studies in women or studies in women and animals are not available. Drugs should be given only if the potential benefit justifies the potential risk to the fetus.

Category D: There is positive evidence of human fetal risk, but the benefits from use in pregnant women may be acceptable despite the risk (e.g., if the drug is needed in a life-threatening situation or for a serious disease for which safer drugs cannot be used or are ineffective).

Category X: Studies in animals or human beings have demonstrated fetal abnormalities or there is evidence of fetal risk based on human experience or both, and the risk of the use of the drug in pregnant women clearly outweighs any possible benefit. The drug is contraindicated in women who are or may become pregnant.
